MAYOR APPOINTMENT, VACANT WARD 3 ALDERMAN SEAT

Appointment of Jill Pigg – Mayor Filley stated Alderman Nemeth resigned at the last meeting. She would like approval of Jill Pigg to serve for the remainder of the term. Motion made by Alderman Presley, seconded by Alderman Eversmeyer. Mayor Filley asked for any discussion. Alderman Lesh asked if we received a written resignation from Alderman Nemeth. Attorney Jones stated it is not required by code, but he did see an e-mail from him that was directed to the Mayor and Administrator. Alderman Cleeve stated we asked about this shortly after being elected with appointments. He had a good conversation with Mrs. Pigg Sunday night, but had a lot going on. He did not find out who the appointment was until Friday. He does not know her, but he feels we have to have more notice and feels rushed with appointments. He is going to be worse next time. Alderman Lesh stated he mentioned this at the last meeting. He thought since this was a seat of an elected person, he believes the people deserve to have the information on this and known ahead of time. People are just hearing about it tonight. He thought it was a good appointment but that doesn't change the fact that he believes people need to know ahead of time, so he would like to see that in the future. For that reason, he will be voting no to this one, as he asked for this last time and have asked for it before. A simple name on the agenda would have

sufficed and he would like to see that in the future. There being no further discussion, a voice vote was taken with an affirmative result. Nays: Alderman Lesh. Whereupon, Mayor Filley declared the vote carried 4-1.
